

How to make a set of map symbol dominoes

What you need

14 Vinyl floor tiles (305mm x 305mm). I used cheap, self adhesive ones from Wilkinson's but I am sure other shops like B&Q would have something similar which you could use.

A set of paper dominoes (28 A4 sheets in this set)

A4 laminating pouches (28)



Method

Print out a set of paper dominoes and trim off the extra paper and then laminate each one .

Do not trim off the extra plastic at this stage.

Cut the the floor tiles in half and then stick a laminated domino to each.

Now trim off the extra laminating plastic and floor tile. Be sure not trim right up to the edge of the paper domino as you need a small border of plastic round the edge of the paper to hold the layers together.

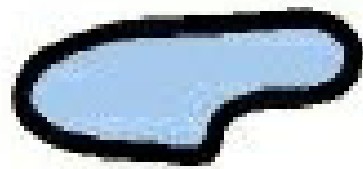
Variations

Use a combination of IOF pictorial descriptions and words. If you make them for the same map symbols as are used in this set both sets could be used together in a truly giant game of dominoes. Print the IOF descriptions on a different colour of paper so that the two sets can be easily identified and separated.





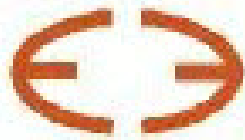
