

## **SOA Challenge 5**

## Folded Wallet

Use a waterproof map - ideally just larger than A4 size.

1. Fold the paper in half, open up and then fold the inner edges to the centre, then fold along the original crease







2. Fold the 2 short edges together. When you open it up you will now have 8 rectangles made by the creases






3. Fold in half along the long edge, and in the 3<sup>rd</sup> box along mark and cut a trapezium shape, ensuring that the shape is smaller than the size of the box. Cut along the folds at the open edge for about 1.5cm (shown in red below).





4. Open up and then fold in the edges on the  $2^{nd}$  and  $4^{th}$  boxes



5. Refold in the original manner as given in step1, by folding the outer edges to the centre and then folding together. You should have one side with the slot (inside of the wallet) and the other will be the outer side.







6. At either end there will be 2 flaps. Trim small triangular shapes from the flaps at either end - this will make them easier to fold in. One flap which will be on the outside of the folded paper (labelled 2) and one towards the inner side (labelled 1).







7. Fold flap 1 forwards into the pocket in front of flap 2. Then fold flap 2 in the opposite direction over this fold and tuck it into the pocket at the other side.





8. Repeat this at the other end, and then make use of your wallet.
