

SOA Challenge 6

Orienteering Map Decopatch

Use your old maps to decorate boxes or other items and bring orienteering into the home!



1. You will need a box, PVA glue, paint brush, old maps and scissors.

Cut the paper up into small pieces - they don't need to be the same size or shape

2. Apply glue to the surface of the object you wish to decorate, then you can start to apply the small pieces of map. It is easiest if you use the paint brush to pick up the paper one square at a time.

Sometimes it is easier to apply a small amount of water to the PVA glue to make it easier to spread.

Apply a layer of glue over the top the square you have just put on.

3. Repeat this process of applying glue both under and on top of each square - smoothing them down with the paint brush.

The pieces of paper can be applied at different angles and with different amounts of overlap.

4. Leave to dry.
