

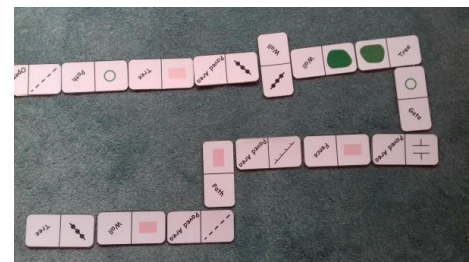
# SOA Challenge 12
