Jan 19th – Cambus O' May. Full club training session.

Introductory block plan – Map setting (cones); Map symbols (flash cards); Mini white / yellow / orange courses available (to suit mixed ages and prior knowledge)
Handouts – loose map legends

Feb 2nd – Bellwood. Local event – 3 courses short, medium (orange), long (light green) Organiser / Planner – Newey / Neumann family

Introductory block plan – Meet and greet; Talk through entry set-up; Enter for appropriate courses; Discuss control descriptions; Talk through white / yellow courses; Demonstrate compass for map setting if appropriate

Handouts – Control description explanation cards. Compasses to borrow.

Feb 9th – Scolty. Full club training session.

Introductory block plan – Merge newcomers into regular club groups according to age and ability level (white / yellow / orange). Consolidate on map setting, symbol interpretation and building confidence for white runners. Yellow courses learn about other line features. Introduce compass for orange.

Mar 1st – Dinnet. Full club training session.

Introductory block plan – Merge newcomers into regular club groups according to age and ability level (white / yellow / orange). Start combined white / yellow groups with fun warm-up game. Then consolidate on map setting, symbol interpretation and building confidence for white and yellow.


Build and consolidate compass skills for orange. Also an opportunity to try out SI kit with micro sprint courses. One white / yellow and 3 ~orange courses.

Introduction to Orienteering

Feb 9th: Skills coaching at Scolty, Banchory

Mar 1st: Skills coaching at Dinnet
